



RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUGUST 21, 2018

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 21, 2018. Roll call was answered by Frank, Davidson and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Davidson. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Davidson to approve the minutes of the August 14, 2018, meeting as read. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Davidson-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

SHERIFF POUNDS

Motion was made by Davidson to approve a computer virus protection proposal submitted by Joe Buckminster of BuckIt, required by federal and state law enforcement agencies for the Law Enforcement Center computers to connect with programming and that will also serve all other computers within the County at a cost of \$3,485.16 for the 1st year

A draft agreement with Southeast Nebraska Communications was reviewed by the Board with Mr. Darveau at this time. The Board will review this agreement with the County Attorney at next week's meeting.

The Board reviewed the FY2018-2019 proposed budgets with County Treasurer, Amanda Bartek-Young and County Clerk-Register of Deeds, Mary L. Eickhoff.


