A VOTE AGAINST: If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the governing body shall not impose the tax.</p> <p><b>PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</b></p> <p>Proposed Amendment No. 1 A vote FOR this amendment will authorize any city, county, or other political subdivision that owns or operates an airport to use its revenue for the purpose of developing or encouraging the development of new or expanded regularly scheduled commercial passenger air service at such airport. A vote AGAINST this amendment will not authorize a city, county, or other political subdivision that owns or operates an airport to use its revenue for such purpose. A constitutional amendment to authorize any city, county, or other political subdivision owning or operating an airport to expend its revenues for the public purpose of developing or encouraging the development of new or expanded regularly scheduled commercial passenger air service at such airport.</p> <p><b>PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION</b></p> <p>Initiative Measure 432 A vote "FOR" will amend the Nebraska Constitution to require that, before casting a ballot in any election, a qualified voter shall present valid photographic identification in a manner specified by the Legislature. A vote "AGAINST" means the Nebraska Constitution will not be amended in this manner.
