**RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
MARCH 26, 2019**

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 26, 2019. Roll call was answered by Frank, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the March 19, 2019, meeting as read. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Kirkendall informed the Board that as part of the Flood Plain Management Program, his department will have to inspect each building/house before the owners will be allowed to enter or do repairs. Kirkendall would like to hire a contractor to assist him with this task. Motion was made by Sickel to allow Kirkendall to hire a contractor to assist with the inspections.
