RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
APRIL 23, 2019

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2019. Roll call was answered by Frank, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the minutes of the April 16, 2019, meeting as read. Motion seconded by Caverzagie. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the agenda as posted. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. The agenda is posted at the Richardson County Courthouse in the First Floor Lobby, the Lower Level Lobby and on the Commissioner's Meeting Room door on the 2nd Floor and on the Richardson County website www.co.richardson.ne.us.

CONSIDER "JUSTICE DATA SOLUTIONS"

Sheriff Pounds and Samantha Scheitel, Deputy County Attorney were requested to meet with the Board regarding the implementation of a records management system to be utilized by the Law Enforcement Center with access available to the County Attorney's Office and NE State Probation Office.

A purchase order for this system less the Civil (\$2,500.00), Administrative (\$1,500.00) and the Property (\$1,500.00) programs was presented by Sheriff Pounds to the Board for consideration.

Commissioner Caverzagie had reviewed the program details with the representative from Justice Data Solutions, Inc. who recommended that the County purchase and utilize the entire program.

Motion was made by Caverzagie that Richardson County purchase the whole system of C.R.I.M.E.S Proposal, Justice Data Solutions as quoted in the amount of \$18,750.00 plus maintenance costs of \$2,000.00 for the Sheriff's Office and that it operate off the server located at the Falls City Police Department. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

SHERIFF DON POUNDS

Sheriff Pounds presented to the Board the condition of the patrol units. The average mileage on the patrol units is 135,200. A pickup that has 193,000 miles needs a transmission and Sheriff Pounds does not recommend that it be replaced.

He also informed the Board that a deputy turned in his 2 weeks notice, as he has accepted another position in another jurisdiction as it provided more salary and an increased benefit package. Sheriff Pounds requested that the Board consider strongly to increase the salary and/or benefit package for the deputies as soon as possible.

AUSTIN DUERFELDT, AG ECONOMIST UNL EXTENSION EDUCATOR

Austin Duerfeldt, Ag Economist Extension Educator with the University of Nebraska Lincoln requested to meet with the Board to inquire on the possibility of the University renting the office space on the 3rd floor of the Courthouse.

Mr. Duerfeldt will take back information to the UNL Extension administration staff to discuss a rental rate and the possibility of creating an inter-local agreement between the University of Nebraska and Richardson County.



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ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT.

Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau, Jr. updated the Board on the routine maintenance of the county roads and bridges this past week.

He reported that the bridge is being worked on at Dawson, rock hauling is being done,

FEMA inspections on bridges have been conducted and that no damage has been found and the department is compiling information on the damage done to the county roads from the flooding and the excessive moisture in March.

Larry Rexroth of rural Humboldt requested to address the Board regarding some water drainage problems on 708 Trail. He also pointed out other areas that need to be graded and/or that need some maintenance.

SEALED BIDS FOR CULVERT MATERIALS

At 11:00 a.m. Chairman Sickel presented the proof of publication for the opening of sealed bids for the purchase of culvert materials. Bids were received from the following: Metal Culverts, Jefferson City, MO; Contech Engineered Solutions, Lincoln, NE; Ace/Eaton Metals, Kearney, NE; Midwest Service & Sales, Schuyler, NE.

Motion was made by Sickel to accept the bids received only for the purpose of further review by the Hwy Supt. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER

Motion was made by Sickel to adopt Resolution 2018-2019-31 to vacate and abandon county road located beginning 33 feet South of the NW corner of the NW quarter of Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 15 E of the 6th P.M. in Richardson County running South along west section line of Section 13, to the North bank of the Nemaha River and beginning approximately 33 ft south of the NE corner of the NE quarter of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 16 East of the 6th P.M. in Richardson County running South along the east Section line of Section 18 to the North bank of the Nemaha River. Portion of road is also known as 648 Ave South of 706 Road. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. (Resolution Book 24, Page)
