RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS JUNE 25, 2019

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Vice-Chairman Frank at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 2019. Roll call was answered by Frank and Caverzagie. Commissioner Sickel was absent. The Invocation was given and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Vice-Chairman Frank announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the June 18, 2019, meeting as read. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the June 18, 2019, Board of Equalization meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the agenda as posted. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried. The agenda is posted at the Richardson County Courthouse in the First Floor Lobby, the Lower Level Lobby and on the Commissioner's Meeting Room door on the 2nd Floor and on the Richardson County website www.co.richardson.ne.us.

SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Sheriff Pounds and Joe Buckminster who serves as the County IT person reviewed with the Board further the implementation of the C.R.I.M.E.S software package that is planned to be installed at the Law Enforcement Center. Mr. Buckminster recommended that the software not be installed on the Falls City Police Department server and that the program should be installed on the server at the Law Enforcement Center. The Board requested that Mr. Buckminster visit with the vendor to review what agencies would be allowed access to the information that will be filed on the software and how a remote monitor could be installed at the Law Enforcement Center to expedite 911 calls received from the Falls City Police Department that the Sheriff Department need to respond to.

Sheriff Pounds also commented on a recent County Court Order that ordered the Richardson County Sheriff to transport a person to the Regional Center. He indicated that the Sheriff's Department is not a transport service and should not be ordered to perform this task.

The Board then met with Deputy, Clinton Stonebarger representing the Sheriff's Deputy staff regarding the pending salary increase. He presented to the Board a revised "Step Pay Scale". After the brief discussion, Commissioner Caverzagie recommended that a salary increase be given at this time and that the Step Pay Scale be tabled for further consideration.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to implement a salary increase for the following Sheriff's Law Enforcement Officer positions effective June 30, 2019: Deputy Sergeant--\$3.44/hour to \$25.35; Investigator--\$3.44/hour to \$25.35; Jail Administrator-Sergeant--\$3.43/hour to \$24.81; Deputy with less than 3 years--\$3.40/hour to \$23.16; Deputy with more than 3 years--\$3.41/hour to \$23.66; Road Sergeant--\$3.44/hour to \$25.35. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT.

Steve Darveau, Highway Superintendent reported on the routine maintenance being done on county roads and bridges this week. Review of the rock hauling and current road conditions was held.



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CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER

Special Designated Liquor License

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve a special designated liquor license for the Falls City Area Jaycees for an event to be held on August 24, 2019 at the Falls City Jaycees Community Field. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.
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CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER (Cont.)

Resolution for Budgets in General Fund Overspent

Motion was made by Caverzagie to adopt Resolution 2018-2019-39 to approve the use and redistribution of unencumbered cash balances of the County General Fund to finance the additional expenditures in the following budgets: Capital Acquisitions budget in the amount of \$1,687.45 and the Veterans Service Office budget in the amount of \$1,291.73. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

Other

Funds in the amount of \$1,140.00 were received from the Department of the Interior under the Payments in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) program which compensates Richardson County for Federal lands administered by Richardson County on behalf of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Funds have been received by the County Treasurer in the General Fund.

CLAIMS

Motion was made by Caverzagie to allow the payment of all claims that were submitted today and to approve partial payment on each claim that has been held for review: 1) Clinton Stonebarger--\$2,341.26 on 5/7/2019—approved \$992.25 for the difference of an 8 hour day to a 10 hour day for calculating payment for holidays and to deny \$1,349.01 for time and a half on holidays worked; 2) Lyle McMann--\$2,764.12 on 5/14/2019—approved \$1,032.75 for the difference of an 8 hour day to a 10 hour day for calculating payment for holidays and to deny \$1,731.37 for time and a half on holidays worked. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.
