## RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OCTOBER 1, 2019

### CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2019. Roll call was answered by Frank, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2019, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Caverzagie. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

### ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT.

Steve Darveau, Highway Superintendent reported on the routine maintenance being done on county roads and bridges this week. He presented information regarding the purchase of a motorgrader to replace the 2004 CAT12H and stated that rock hauling is continuing with all trucks running and having to go to Pawnee City area for the rock. Discussion was also held on the condition of the motorgrader garages in the villages and that they are need to be upgraded and/or replaced due to the lack of space for the storage of the new motorgraders which are bigger.

Brian Kirkendall, EMA Director also met with the Board at this time with Mr. Darveau to review the possibility of purchasing the software program, ORION. Motion was made by Caverzagie to purchase the ORION software package to assist with the documentation for damages to report to FEMA. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

### LAURA OSBORNE, 4 COUNTY JUVENILE SERV GRANT

Laura Osborne, Project Director of the Four County Juvenile Services Program grant through the Nebraska Crime Commission informed the Board that the grant application for the next fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 is due on December 20, 2019 and that the grant will no longer require local matching funds.
