RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS NOVEMBER 17, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Vice-Chairman Frank at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 17, 2020. Roll call was answered by Frank and Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel was absent. The Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance were given and led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Vice-Chairman Frank announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2020 meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

COURTHOUSE MAINTENANCE

Tammie Beckner, Courthouse Maintenance reviewed with the Board the status of the underground fuel storage tank at the Courthouse. She is needing to renew her certification for testing the tank and inquired as to the schedule in the removal of the tank from the Courthouse grounds. The Board will be making arrangements to get the tank emptied and Brian Kirkendall is investigating possible contractors who can remove the tank.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau, Jr. did not meet with the Board this week due to involvement with road maintenance projects being done today.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Sheriff Hardesty and Chief Deputy Sheriff, Roland Merwin updated the Board on the routine business within the Law Enforcement Center this week. A boarding prisoner contract has been received from Otoe County and will be acted on at next week's meeting.

VETERANS SERVICE OFFICE

Mona Godemann, Veterans Service Officer presented to the Board information on replacing the van that has been provided to Richardson County by the Disabled Americans Veterans Transportation Network Program.

Motion was made by Frank to approve the acquisition of a 2021 Ford Transit Connect, 7 passenger van which is being made available to Richardson County through the 2021 DAV Transportation Network Program with Richardson County agreeing to provide a cost-share amount of \$14,119.00 to apply towards the full cost of \$25,672.00. Motion seconded by Caverzagie. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-absent. Motion carried.

Mrs. Godemann also informed the Board that the current DAV van being used which was also provided to Richardson County through the DAV Transportation Network Program will become the property of Richardson County to be used in other departments of the County when the new van is acquired.
