**RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
NOVEMBER 24, 2020**

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 24, 2020. Roll call was answered by Frank, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Frank. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room which have been updated effective November 14, 2020.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the November 17, 2020, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Frank. ROLL CALL VOTE: Frank-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

Steve Darveau, Jr. updated the Board on the routine maintenance being done on county roads and bridges this past week.

Discussion was held on removing the fuel from the underground storage tank at the Courthouse and Mr. Darveau reported that Sapp Bros. would be able to pump the fuel from the storage tank in the next week or so.

BRIAN KIRKENDALL, EMA DIRECTOR

Brian Kirkendall, EMA Director presented to the Board the updated Radiological Emergency Plan for Richardson County. Motion was made by Frank to approve the Radiological Emergency Plan for Richardson County as presented by EMA Director, Brian Kirkendall. Motion seconded by Sickel. Sheriff Hardesty updated the Board on the routine business within the Law Enforcement Center. He reported that due to some staff out with COVID19 that there will be quite a bit of overtime on the next several payrolls.
