RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APRIL 6, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

The annual meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 6, 2021. Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws are posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes as corrected of the March 30, 2021, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the minutes of the Board of Equalization meeting of March 30, 2021 as presented. Motion seconded by Caverzagie. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT

Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau updated the Board on the routine maintenance being done on county roads and bridges this week. Mr. Darveau informed the Board that there will be 37 bridge inspections that will need to be done this year and the NE Dept. of Transportation will not be assisting the counties with this and that he is obtaining quotes from licensed inspectors to complete a portion of the inspections that are due.

Motion was made by Karas to adopt Resolution 2020-2021-38 to vacate and abandon a portion of County Road between S32, T2, R15 and S5, T1, R15 described as a road beginning approximately 550 west of the SE corner of the SE ¼ of Section 32, Township 2, Range 15 and at the NE corner of the NE ¼ of Section 5, Township 1, Range 15 running westerly 1,410 feet.
