RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS JULY 6, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 6, 2021. Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws are posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the final minutes of the June 29, 2021, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the minutes of the June 29, 2021 Board of Equalization meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT

The Board met with Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau to review the routine business within the Road and Bridge Department.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve a 2% salary increase for the road foreman and the administrative assistant effective July 1, 2021. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Sheriff Hardesty and Chief Deputy Sheriff, Roland Merwin updated the Board on the routine business within the Sheriff’s Department and Jail this past week. Salary increases for the staff at the Law Enforcement Center were also reviewed and further discussion will be held during next week’s meeting.

Motion was made by Karas after adopting Resolution 2020-2021-56 to waive the bidding requirements as it was deemed that an emergency exists, to enter into a contract with First Wireless for communication tower and radio equipment for a total price of \$398,489.49. Motion seconded by Caverzagie. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/OTHER

Region V Agreement

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve an agreement with Region V Systems for Emergency Protective Care services at a cost of \$214.00/day for EPC patients. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Sickel to approve a subdivision for Rodger L. Merz, etal located in S35, T3, R16 and to adopt Resolution 2021-2022-1.
