RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEPTEMBER 28, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 28, 2021. Roll call was answered by Karas and Sickel. Commissioner Caverzagie was absent. The Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance were led by Chairman Sickel. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws are posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Karas to approve the final minutes of the September 21, 2021, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-absent, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the agenda as posted. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-absent, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT

The Board met with Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau to review the routine business within the Road and Bridge Department.

Motion was made by Sickel to adopt Resolution 2021-2022-14 regarding the reclassification of one half (1/2) mile of minimum maintenance road to local described as: Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 13 East running east for one half (1/2) mile or which is located on 708 Road from 630 Avenue running ½ mile east. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-absent, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. (Resolution Book 26, Page 36)

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Sheriff Hardesty and Chief Deputy Sheriff, Roland Merwin updated the Board on the routine business with the Law Enforcement Center and Jail.

Motion was made by Karas to approve an agreement with Tiger Correctional Services for commissary services for inmates at the Law Enforcement Center. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-absent, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.

Curt Field and Huey of Prochaska and Associates met with the Board to review the Jail inmate space and just a few options to consider for adding more beds to the current facility. They explained to the Board that a feasibility study would probably be required before considering an addition to the existing facility. The Board will continue the review of the possibility of adding more beds to the current facility.

RENO DRY USA

Michael Clancy and Don Brown of RenoDry USA from Overland Park, KS, via a teleconference, reviewed with the Board further the report that was presented at last week's meeting.

Motion was made by Karas to approve the purchase of the installation of the RenoDry USA system at the Richardson County Courthouse for a total price of \$11,325.00. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-absent, Sickel-aye. Motion carried.
