RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OCTOBER 19, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Karas to adopt Resolution 2021-2022-17 to change the number of deputies with the Sheriff’s Department to add a full-time deputy to serve as a transport officer with the stipulation that if it proves at any time at a later date to be unnecessary then the position will be removed. 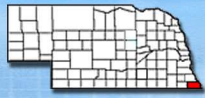
DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS QUARTERLY MEETING

Brian Kirkendall reported that there is a concern in the room at the Courthouse where the phone service and internet service are connected within the building and suggested that an electrician needed to be contacted to install more outlets in the area to avoid the use of extension cords and power strips. A letter received from concerned citizens regarding the dress code within the Courthouse was also reviewed at this time.
