

RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS NOVEMBER 2, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the October 26, 2021, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickele-aye. Motion carried. ROAD DEPARTMENT

Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau, Jr. met with the Board to update them on the routine maintenance being done this week on County roads and bridges. Mr. Darveau also informed the Board that the engineering firm is working to complete the bid specifications for the asphalt projects to be done this next year.

Notification was received from the State of NE Board of Classifications and Standards approving the reclassification of a road from minimum maintenance to local classification as requested by the County in Resolution 2021-2022-14. This road is described as beginning at the southwest corner of Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 13 East running east for one half (1/2) mile or which is located on 708 Road from 630 Avenue running ½ mile east.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Chief Deputy Roland Merwin updated the Board this week on the business of the Law Enforcement Center.

Courthouse would be eligible for funding through the ARPA funds. A discussion was also held regarding the possibility of continued legislation on the ARPA funds through H.R. 5735 introduced to Congress in the past week which would offer more options for the use of the ARPA funds to benefit the County.
