**RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
DECEMBER 6, 2022**

## **CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 6, 2022. Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Caverzagie. Chairman Sickel announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve the minutes of the November 29, 2022, meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-abstain. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sickel to approve the agenda as posted. Motion seconded by Karas. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. ## **LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER**

Sheriff Hardesty was unable to attend the meeting but the Board held a discussion on approving the advancement of a hiring bonus in which the County Attorney's Office is preparing a contract to enter into with the employee(s) and for the Board to review this matter further at next week's meeting. The Sheriff's Department is also considering the purchase of a drug dog and this also will be discussed further at next week's meeting.

## **ROAD AND BRIDGE DEPARTMENT**

Highway Superintendent, Steve Darveau, Jr. briefly updated the Board on the routine maintenance being done on County Roads and Bridges this past week. He reported to the Board that an application for an overweight/oversize vehicle permit had been submitted to the County with fees paid and have now been notified that the project has been cancelled. The Board approved the refund of the \$100.00 permit fee.

Mr. Darveau also presented to the Board the notice to bidders for the construction of a concrete box culvert to replace a bridge located 3 miles east and 3 miles north of Falls City on 655 Avenue approximately 1800 feet south of 710 Road. The bid opening will be held on Tuesday, January 10, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.

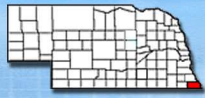
## **BRIAN KIRKENDALL, EMA DIRECTOR**

Motion was made by Caverzagie to adopt Resolution 2022-2023-23 to adopt the Richardson County Local Operations Plan (LEOP) in order to provide for a coordinated response to a disaster or emergency within Richardson County. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Caverzagie-aye, Sickel-aye. Motion carried. (Resolution Book 26, Page 106)
