CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Sickel at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 27, 2022. Roll call was answered by Karas, Caverzagie and Sickel. The Invocation was given by Chairman Sickel and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Karas. Sheriff Hardesty updated the Board on the routine business within the Law Enforcement Center this past week. Discussion was held regarding the use of the metal building to the north of the Law Enforcement Center to be used as an evidence storage area. He reported that the light on the communications tower has been repaired and that St. Plumbing is trying to remedy the sewer problem at the Law Enforcement Center to eliminate the smell. The Sheriff also reported that the jailers have been issued body cams to help with clarity on specific situations within the Jail from time to time.

SUE KROGMAN, NRIN

Sue Krogman of the NE Regional Interoperability Network met with the Board to update them on the progress of the installation of NRIN system within Richardson County. The plans are to complete the project by Fall of 2023. The Board approved the continuation of this installation to move forward with the system within Richardson County.
