### LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Sheriff Hardesty updated the Board on the routine business within the Law Enforcement Center this week. An oral report on the activity performed by the Sheriff's Department was given to the Board.

Motion was made by Caverzagie to approve a First Addendum to a Service Agreement for Inmate Health Services with the Community Medical Center, Inc. a Nebraska nonprofit corporation dated May, 2020, in which the annual cost shall be increased to \$60,000 (\$5,000/month).
